


Figure 1. Internal schematic diagram






Figure 4. Output characteristics





Figure 6. Normalized BV<sub>DSS</sub> vs temperature Figure 7. Static drain-source on resistance



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Figure 8. Gate charge vs gate-source voltage Figure 9. Capacitance variations




Figure 10. Normalized gate threshold voltage Figure 11. Normalized on resistance vs vs temperature temperature





Figure 12. Maximum avalanche energy vs temperature

Figure 15. Gate charge test circuit




Figure 16. Test circuit for inductive load switching and diode recovery times

Figure 17. Unclamped Inductive load test circuit





Figure 18. Unclamped inductive waveform

Figure 19. Switching time waveform


